

## Paper Preparation and pdf-express Conversion Instructions

The 2008 PMC Conference Proceedings is an IEEE publication, and a specific format must be followed. To ensure that your work is included in these proceedings, **2008 PMC** has registered for use of a new IEEE tool: **IEEE PDF eXpress™**. The new IEEE Xplore® Requirements for PDF will be enforced and all conference articles submitted for inclusion in IEEE *Xplore* must adhere to the IEEE *Xplore* PDF specification for compatibility.

IEEE PDF eXpress is a free service to allow their authors to make IEEE *Xplore*-compatible PDFs (Conversion function) or to check PDFs that authors have made themselves for IEEE *Xplore* compatibility (PDF Check function).

The submission deadline is **23-May-2008**. **Manuscripts must be *Xplore*-compatible before final submission.**

**Please Read the entire document before you proceed if you are not familiar with IEEE PDF Express.**

### ***Steps for Paper Preparation:***

1. Create your manuscript(s)
2. Proof read and check layout of manuscript following the guidelines specified in the "**Sample Manuscript**" (it is highly recommended that you do this BEFORE going to IEEE PDF eXpress). The "**Sample Manuscript**" can be found at the link:

3. Use IEEE PDF eXpress to obtain IEEE *Xplore*-compatible PDF(s). The site contains extensive instructions, resources, helpful hints, and access to technical support. The instructions to access the PDF eXpress is given below.
4. Create IEEE PDF eXpress account at (<http://216.228.1.34/pdfexpress/log.asp>) (**see instructions on how to access the PDF Express below**)
5. Upload source file(s) to **IEEE PDF eXpress** for Conversion; and/or PDF(s) for Checking (<http://216.228.1.34/pdfexpress/log.asp>)
6. Submit final, IEEE *Xplore*-compatible PDF(s).
7. Bring a signed, completed copy of the **IEEE Copyright Form** to the conference. The copyright form can be found at the following link.

## Please Read the entire document before you proceed if you are not familiar with IEEE PDF Express.

### **IEEE PDF eXpress converts the following file types to PDF:**

Rich Text Format  
Freelance  
(La)TeX (DVI and all support files required)\*  
PageMaker  
FrameMaker QuarkXpress\*  
Word Pro  
Microsoft Word  
WordPerfect

\*For documents created in formats that do not embed source files, include all support files with the final manuscript in a folder. Put this folder in a compressed archive for submission. If it is possible to embed images in the source document, you should do so to avoid potential issues, such as missing graphics.

**IMPORTANT:** A DVI (DeVice Independent file) is required for LaTeX conversions, in addition to all associated image files. Make sure that your LaTeX system can output a DVI, otherwise it cannot be converted. Be sure also to check that your images are properly referenced, and that DVI can handle the image file types used (DVI does not handle some newer image types, such as \*.png).

### **Instructions to access to IEEE PDF express**

Conference ID: **ipmc08x**

1. Access the IEEE PDF eXpress site (**web-address given above**)

*First-time users:*

- a. Click "New Users"
- b. Enter **ipmc08x** for the Conference ID, your email address, and choose a new password. Continue to enter information as prompted.
- c. You will receive online and email confirmation of successful account setup.

*Previous users, but using it the first time for a new conference:*

- a. Enter **ipmc08x** for the Conference ID, your email address, and enter the password you used for your old account.
- b. When you click "Login", you'll receive an error saying you need to set up an account. Simply click "Continue". By entering your previously used email address and password combination, you will enable your old account for access to this new conference.
- c. Check that the contact information is still valid, and click "Submit".
- d. You will receive online and email confirmation of successful account setup.

*Returning users:*

- a. Enter **ipmc08x** for the Conference ID, email address and password

2. For each conference paper, click "Create New Title".
3. Enter identifying text for the paper (title is recommended but not required)
4. Click "Submit PDF for Checking" or "Submit Source Files for Conversion"
5. Indicate platform, source file type (if applicable), click Browse and navigate to file, and click "Upload File". You will receive online and email confirmation of successful upload

6. You will receive an email with your Checked PDF or IEEE PDF eXpress-converted PDF attached. If you submitted a PDF for Checking, the email will show if your file passed or failed.
7. Please see the following table for possible problems and solutions to get your manuscript converted properly.

Option 2	Read the PDF Check report, then click "The PDF Check Report" in the sidebar to get information on possible solutions	Submit a PDF by clicking <b><u>Try again</u></b> , then <b><u>Submit PDF for Checking</u></b>	Submit your IEEE Xplore-compatible PDF ( <i>Submission site web address will be sent to contact author via e-mail.</i> )
