Well, the team finally got Report #2 submitted, where we justified our selection of a through-the-road parallel, hybrid-electric vehicle architecture utilizing a small Diesel engine driving the front wheels along with a permanent magnet electric motor to drive the rear wheels. The engine will be powered by B20 biodiesel and the electric motor by a NiMH battery pack. Through the use of PSAT simulations, the team predicts the MSU Equinox will offer a 39% improvement in fuel economy and a 20% improvement in acceleration performance.

The team is relieved to have Report #2 completed, but with the next deliverables fast approaching, there is no time to rest. Besides completing those dreaded final exams, the team is currently working diligently toward procuring the powertrain components that will be needed to build the MSU Equinox powertrain subsystem. The team plans to use the extra time during the Holidays to procure several critical powertrain items that require extended delivery lead times.
